

- Shipping lanes are for shipping, as governed by IMO.
- Consider **safety distances around shipping lanes** of min. 500 meters to reduce risks of e.g. power failures or emergency turns.
- **Marine Protected Areas** (MPAs) are areas of avoidance for all other uses.
- Conventional offshore wind farms can only be built in areas up to 30 meters deep.
- Floating offshore wind farms can only be built in areas up to 60 meters deep.
- Cables should cross shipping routes as perpendicular (right-angled) as possible to reduce the risk of breakage in case of emergency anchoring.
- Cables should follow the shortest and most direct route to shore
